JOHN 6

- Jesus feeds the 5,000. They want to make him king.
 - Later that night the disciples cross the lake, and Jesus walks on water.
 - The next people search everywhere and they find Jesus.
 - John 6:26-36
 - He argues back and forth with the people.
 - It's the Father's will for none to be lost.
 - It's His will that all who believe will have eternal life.
 - Everyone will be taught, but only those who listen and believe will be saved.
 - "Your ancestors ate manna and died..."
 - Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood will have eternal life.
 - "I am the bread that came down from heaven."
 - Many disciples leave; he looks to the twelve.
1. You want to be with me because I fed you, not because you understand.
Don't spend your time on perishable things, but on the eternal life Jesus can give.
 2. The only work that God wants from you is to believe in the one whom he sent. (Prove it) (Manna)
 3. The true bread from heaven is the Son of Man, and he comes to give life to the world. (Jesus is the bread of life)

SEEK ETERNAL LIFE, NOT THIS WORLD

- The people pursued Jesus because they wanted something from him.
- They wanted him as king because for temporal reasons.
- The Bible is filled with examples of this conversation.
- God cares way more about the eternal than the temporal.
- 1 John 2:15-17, 1 John 5:21, Matthew 6:25-31
- Why are you pursuing Jesus? Is it only for your next meal?
- Do you want him as king because of what he can do for you?
- Are you upset and asking for proof in your heart?

THE ONLY WORK HE WANTS IS FOR YOU TO BELIEVE

- John 6:40, John 6:45
- All who believe have eternal life.
- Everyone will be taught.
- Ephesians 2:8-10
- A free gift can't be earned.
- Human effort is worthless.
- Philippians 3:3
- Exodus 16:17-19

JESUS IS LIFE

- John 6:47-51
- Isaiah 55:1-3
- Man doesn't live by bread alone

QUESTIONS:

1. What stood out to you in this week's message?
2. Read John 6:26-36 & 1 John 2:15-17
 - a) Ask- In what ways do you get caught up chasing the things of the world?
 - b) Ask- Do you ever get upset when God doesn't do what you expect or give you what you want, or do what you want him to do in a situation?
3. Do you have a hard time believing that the only thing God wants from you is to believe in the one whom he sent, and follow and trust him?
4. Read Ephesians 2:8-10 & Philippians 3:3
Ask- What do you take from these verses and how can you apply its truth to your life in this season?
5. Read Exodus 16:17-19
 - A) Ask- Are you someone who gathers for the next day or goes to God each day in trust in this season?
 - B) What is a step you can take after hearing the last two weeks of this series?
6. Read Isaiah 55:1-3
Ask- What is this verse trying to teach us?
