Matthew 6:9-13 (NIV)-

LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION

Temptation / pi-ras-mos'

- o an experiment, attempt, trial, proving the trial of man's fidelity, integrity, virtue, constancy
- o an enticement to sin, whether arising from the internal desires or from the outward circumstances
- o the condition of things, or a mental state, by which we are enticed to sin, or to lapse from the faith and holiness
- o adversity, affliction, trouble:

- James 1:13-15
- God allows tempting to take place but he shows us a way out (1 Corinthians 10:12-13)
- We go through trials that often surprise us
- Don't be surprised (1 Peter 4:12-14)
- Testing is the same word / pi-ras-mos'
- As we go through trials, temptations, and testing, God works good from them even in our failures
- Our faith is more precious than gold (1 Peter 1:6-9 (NLT) -
- Trials is the same word / pi-ras-mos'
- God is with us (Isaiah 43:2-3)
- Examples of failure in the Bible
- Luke 22:31-34-

DELIVER US FROM THE EVIL ONE

- We are in a war
- The Devil is:
- He is defeated
- Colossians 2:13- (We have victory)
- We don't fight like humans
- 2 Corinthians 10:3-5- (Capture thoughts)
- Armor of God
- Romans 8:35-38- (Nothing can separate us)
