Opening Question: What has been your experience with missions? Have you ever been on a mission trip?

Main Point: Missions at Real Life is about making disciples around the world. Real Life's approach is less "evangelical" and less event-based. We don't aim to Americanize foreign churches. We build long-term relationships and have volunteer leaders that are constantly encouraging pastors and leaders around the world. The local church body being and making disciples provides the credibility needed to multiply this model internationally.

Questions:

Head

- What is the difference between making disciples and converts?
- What stood out to you about the difference between most mission trips and the model that Real Life subscribes to?

Heart

- How does God's work on a global scale impact you personally?
- How have you experienced someone being "missional" in your life, and how did that make a difference for you?

Hands

- How is God calling you to be involved with reaching the world? (Prayer, small group involvement, giving, inquiring about the mission team, seeing your world sphere as a mission field?)
