Ephesians 6:1-3

- This doesn't mean no boundaries.
- God has a design for relationships and authority.

2. The older pouring into the younger (Titus 2:1-12)
3. Correction (Proverbs 12:1)
4. Healthy relationships & intake
5. Be an example (1 Timothy 4:12)
