

## Shoes of the Gospel of Peace

### Ephesians 6:13-15 ESV

Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace."

### Readiness

ἑτοιμασία (hetoimasia)

Used 1x in all of scripture.

Means: preparation, be ready

### **Nail #1: Submit to the Lord**

#### Matthew 28:18-20 ESV

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

### **Nail #2: Expect Opposition**

#### 2 Chronicles 20:17 ESV

"You will not need to fight in this battle. Stand firm, hold your position, and see the salvation of the Lord on your behalf, O Judah and Jerusalem.' Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed. Tomorrow go out against them, and the Lord will be with you."

### **Nail #3: God Fights for Us**

#### Romans 10:13-15 ESV

<sup>13</sup> For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." <sup>14</sup> How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? <sup>15</sup> And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"

### Evangelist & Good News

εὐαγγέλιον (euangelion) – Good News

εὐαγγελιστής (euaggelistés) – Evangelist

Means: Missionary, Bearer of good news
