

Nothing Can Separate Us From God’s Love

Matthew 24:35 (NIV) - *Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.*

2 Peter 1:3-9 (NLT) - ³*By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. ⁴And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world’s corruption caused by human desires.*

⁵*In view of all this, make every effort to respond to God’s promises. Supplement your faith with a generous provision of moral excellence, and moral excellence with knowledge, ⁶and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with patient endurance, and patient endurance with godliness, ⁷and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love for everyone.*

⁸*The more you grow like this, the more productive and useful you will be in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹But those who fail to develop in this way are shortsighted or blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their old sins.*

Promise #2 - Nothing can separate you from God’s love

My sin is great. God’s love is greater.

Romans 8:1 (NIV) - *Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,*

Romans 8:31-32 (NLT) - ³¹*What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? ³²Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won’t he also give us everything else?*

Psalm 118:6 (NKJV)

Romans 8:33 (NLT) - ³³*Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself.*

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NIV)

Romans 8:34 (NLT) - ³⁴ Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us.

1 John 3:20 (NIV) // 1 John 2:1 (NLT)

Romans 8:35-37 (NLT) - ³⁵ Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? ³⁶ (As the Scriptures say, "For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.") ³⁷ No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.

2 Corinthians 4:16-18 (NIV)

Romans 8:38-39 (NLT) - ³⁸ And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. ³⁹ No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.
