“Missions Week”

Matthew 4:19 (ESV) “And he said to them, “Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.”

1. If you are a Christian, you are a disciple of Jesus:

- a. A disciple is one who follows Jesus.
- b. A disciple is one who is being changed by Jesus.
- c. A disciple is one who is on Jesus's mission.

2. What is Jesus's mission?

Luke 19:10 (NIV) “For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”

- a. It is estimated that over 5.6 billion people are spiritually lost.

3. What is our mission as a church?

- a. “To reach the world for Jesus one person at a time.”

Matthew 28:18-20 (NIV) “Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

- b. What do we mean by “To reach”?
 - i. “Go and make disciples”
 - ii. “Baptize”
 - iii. “Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you”
- c. How do we “reach the world for Jesus one person at a time”
 - i. Start by being a disciple of Jesus.
 1. Who is discipling you?

“I can teach what I know, but I will reproduce who I am” (Maxwell).

- ii. Then learn to be a disciple-maker.
 1. Who are you discipling?

1 Corinthians 11:1 (ESV) “Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.”

- d. Where am I to be making-disciples?
 - i. Family, neighbors, coworkers, community, country, the world.

4. How does Real Life do international missions?

- a. Ordinary people make kingdom-impact by relationally coaching national senior pastors in relational discipleship through online platforms and by traveling there.
- b. **Caution:** We don't want to become a church that is good at teaching and speaking about something we don't do.
 - i. Doing relational discipleship in Idaho gives our missions team credibility to speak abroad.

- a. We are working *directly* with **28** Key Pastors across **17** countries.
- b. Those Key Pastors, in turn, are working with other Key Pastors in *more than* **45** countries, impacting over **45,000** churches worldwide.
