GROUP QUESTIONS:

1. When you think about Jesus as your leader, what is one thing about the way He leads that stands out to you?
2. Jesus is compassionate, humble, gentle, and willing to serve. Which of these qualities of Jesus means the most to you right now, and why?
3. Hebrews 3 shows us that Moses was a faithful servant, but Jesus is the Son over God's house. What does this teach us about why Jesus is worthy of our trust and obedience?
4. Read Luke 6:46-49. What is the difference between simply hearing what Jesus says and actually building your life on what He says? What is an area of your life where it can be difficult to let Jesus lead instead of trying to stay in control yourself?
5. Israel witnessed God's faithfulness again and again, yet they still struggled to trust Him. Why do you think we can sometimes do the same thing?
6. Hebrews 3 warns us not to harden our hearts. What are some things that can make our hearts less receptive to what God is saying?
7. Hebrews 3 says, "Today when you hear his voice." What are some ways God uses His Word and other believers to speak truth into our lives?
8. Hebrews 3:13 tells us to encourage one another every day. Why do we need other believers helping us stay faithful to Christ?
9. Isaiah 55:3 says, "Come to me with your ears wide open. Listen, and you will find life." What would it look like for you to have your "ears wide open" to God this week?
10. In Matthew 13, Jesus describes different ways people respond to God's Word. What can we do to cultivate a heart that receives God's Word and allows it to produce fruit?
11. After looking at Jesus as our greatest leader, what is one area where you believe He is calling you to trust Him, follow Him, or obey Him more fully this week?
